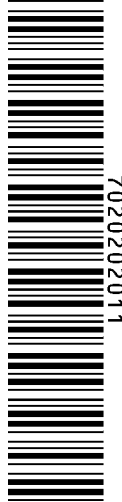

Original Return Payment Options
